






Online Winter Book Study:

Workshop/Course Description:

This book study discussion group is designed to encourage interpreters and students to learn about power, privilege, and oppression through the lens of gender inclusion. The participants' answers must show they have completely read the section and have enough knowledge of the topic to become actively involved in group discussion.
