SHADOWS IN TRAUMA

- ⇒ Will examine the various ways trauma impacts Deaf/hard of hearing survivors of domestic violence and sexual violence (DSDV) along with secondary trauma on interpreters. Practical tools will be applied from case study scenarios giving opportunity to practice with others on the interpretation process as they relate to trauma-informed situations
- ⇒ **Participants will:**
 - ◇ Be introduced to basic concepts of DSDV along with power and control concepts
 - ◇ Learn at least 4 abuse tactics people who cause harm use against Deaf/hh people
 - ◇ Learn at least 2 biological effects of trauma on an individual
 - ◇ Learn about interpreting in DSDV content in various settings.

Holly Elkins works at the Indiana Coalition Against Domestic Violence (ICADV) as the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Coordinator providing technical assistance to DV programs & services in addition to implementing services for Deaf/hh survivors of DV.
