Tuesday, April 19th, 2022—Classifiers and STEM

The employment market in science, technology, engineering and mathematics rapidly grows. Take a closer look at ASL features to employ to enhance interpretation in a STEM classroom. At the conclusion of this workshop students will be able to define a STEM based teaching approach. Participants will demonstrate appropriate use of classifiers to describe an object's mass, volume, length, shape, or number as well as a classifier to describe how an object interacts with its environment.

Interpreting Math

At times understanding the language of math is similar to other language learning. Delve into some basic concepts to ensure strong foundations in deaf and hard of hearing math learners.
